## FILE NAMES

The IR file names follow the rules below.

Ex.) CA<sup>1</sup> \_TS<sup>2</sup> \_SM57<sup>3</sup> \_1inch<sup>4</sup> \_off<sup>5</sup> \_1<sup>6</sup>.wav


① The name of the cabinet.

② The name of the speaker unit.

- ③ The name of the microphone.
- ④ The distance from the amplifier grill cloth to the microphone.

The on/off axis of the microphone placement.



- ⑥ The serial number of the microphone placement. The smaller number is close to the center cap and the larger number is close to the cone edge.
